Southeast Colorado Power Association offering renewable incentive program to members

La Junta, CO – Southeast Colorado Power Association recently announced the adoption of a renewable generation incentive program for its residential members. The program offers a \$2 per-watt incentive to qualifying residential members for grid-connected solar and/or wind power.

“We felt there was need to help our members who wanted to participate in renewable energy to do so by offering incentives,” said CEO Rich Wilson. “With the abundance of both sunshine and wind resources within our service territory, we feel that the program is a good fit for our members. We hope this helps our members who want to participate in renewable energy to do so.”

The cooperative also offers a net metering program to customer-generators who supply a part or all of their electricity from a solar, wind, biomass or hydropower generating facility.
